This Week's Story: David & Goliath

As the years passed, the people of Israel ended up in a fierce war with a tribe called the Philistines whose champion warrior was a fierce giant called Goliath.

None of the Israelites could beat Goliath until the day a young shepherd boy called David went to meet him with the sling he used to defend his flocks of sheep from wolves and lions.

David took five small stones, and faced Goliath. With one small stone in his sling he knocked the giant down!

The Israelites beat the Philistines with David the young Shepherd boy as their champion!

Knock down Goliath!

- Colour in and cut out the picture of Goliath
- Stick it on a cardboard tube.
- Try to knock it down with a ball of rolled up paper!

Five Little Stones: Using five small soft objects (such as pompoms) to represent David's stones there are two games you can play

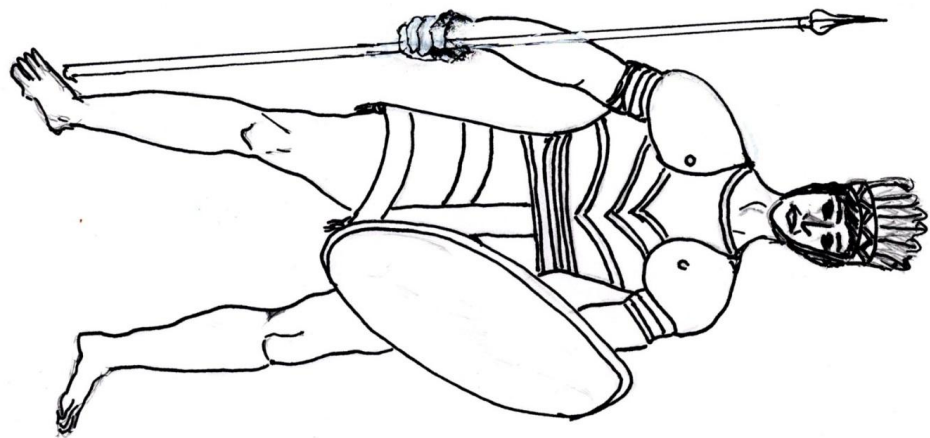
- 1:** Throw each 'stone' up in turn and try to catch them on either the palm or back of your hand. When playing against someone else whoever catches the most wins.
- 2:** Put the stones on the floor: Throw a ball in the air and pick up a stone before it bounces: Throw again and pick up two stones before the ball bounces: Keep going in the same pattern until you can pick up all five stones and catch the ball before it bounces!
